

Cordley Lake boat storage meeting
Saturday April 17, 2021

Purpose of meeting: To organize the storage of the boats along the southeast shoreline of Cordley Lake by labeling all boats with stickers, relocating to approved areas and removing boats that are not labeled in the fall.

Action Plan:

- All members will be notified of the need to purchase annual stickers for all boats stored in this area. This notification will be included in the annual meeting packet. Areas will be designated for rowboats, jon boats, canoes, paddleboats and kayaks.
- The Boats Harbor and Lakes Director will be selling stickers at the annual meeting.
- Members are asked to fill out an application with contact and boat information to receive their stickers. The cost is \$20.00 per sticker (one sticker per boat). The revenue will be used to clear brush, repair boat racks and build additional storage.
- Work parties will begin cleaning and organizing the storage racks starting with the rack to the north of the dock this summer. As the work party proceeds, boats without current stickers will be moved to a temporary holding area along the brush between the Cordley Lake and the boat launch area.
- All boats must be removed from the storage area by November 30. If needed, a work party led by Hans Frazer will provide assistance moving the boats to your home. Any boats not displaying a current WLO sticker by November 30, will be considered abandoned and disposed of. Boats with current stickers may be returned to the storage area the following spring any time after April 1st.
- All paddleboat anchorage poles in Cordley Lake must be removed in the fall. An area approximately 10 foot wide adjacent on the south side of the dock will be reserved for launching electric powered fishing boats for day usage and will not be available for paddleboat anchorage.
